What are "Regionals"?

Each of the nine Skate Canada Manitoba Regions host a competition in January. Skaters participating in the StarSkate Program are eligible to compete in their region. The top three placements in qualifying events from each region advance to the Manitoba StarSkate Championships (Provincials). The Winnipeg Region consists of 4 clubs, including our own Century Skating Club. The 2010 Regionals had over 70 competitors!

What is the Manitoba Open?

The Manitoba Open FreeSkate Competition is the largest of its kind in Manitoba and is open to all registered StarSkate and Competitive Skaters from Canada and the United States. This year's MB Open held in Beausejour drew over 230 competitors from within and outside of Manitoba.
